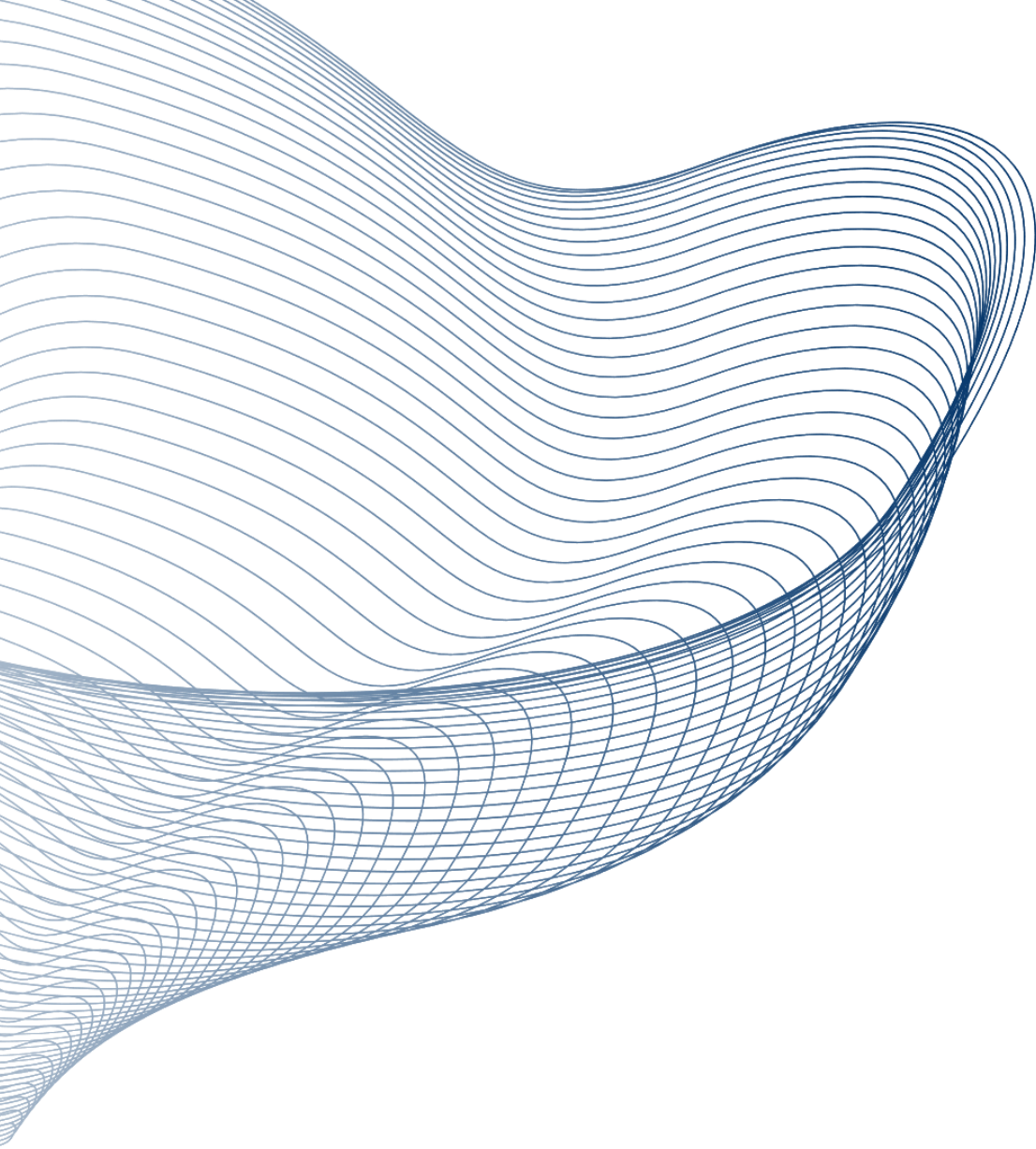
Introduction
